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Safety

Operation

Before operating game, read this manual. Failure to properly install and operate this game could result in malfunction or accident. Operate the game in accordance with the manual.

Transporting

The upper monitor assembly weighs approximately 95 lbs. and the installation requires a minimum of three people, using two 6-foot step ladders (minimum height). It is preferred that the main cabinet be moved to or very near its desired operational location before beginning any of the set-up tasks. It is also strongly recommended that the game NOT be moved with the monitor installed in the upright position. It contains fragile glass and electronic components. Avoid rough handling.

Handling Components

Many components are extremely sensitive to handling, environmental and Electrostatic Discharge (ESD) events—especially the computer. Do not handle it roughly. Before servicing, contact your distributor and inquire about the PC warranty. Use proper ESD procedures when servicing. Protect components from harmful environmental conditions, such as extreme temperatures, excessive moisture, or other damaging effects.

Disconnect Power

Always turn the power off and unplug the unit before servicing or making adjustments unless otherwise instructed. Installing or repairing components while power is on can damage the components and void the warranty.

Grounding

Avoid electrical shock. Do not plug in AC power until you have inspected and properly grounded the unit. Only plug into a grounded, three-wire outlet. Do not use a “cheater” plug or cut off the ground pin on the line cord.

Electrical Shocks

There is no isolation transformer in the cabinet. Disconnect AC power before servicing. However, be aware that lethal voltages can remain in the electronic components even when AC power is disconnected. Use extreme caution when servicing. Verify that there is a working ground connection. If the unit sustains water damage, cease using it immediately and unplug AC power.

Monitor

The monitors contain no user serviceable parts. Do not attempt to service the monitors.

Power Selector

The game is fixed for operation at either 120VAC or 230VAC, indicated by a large orange label on the back of the cabinet. The accepted AC mains voltage cannot be modified by the operator.

Power Cord

If the power cord is damaged or lost, replace it with an identical cord as supplied by the manufacturer or an authorized service agent.

Surge Suppressor

It is recommended that you plug your game's power cord into a surge suppressor to help protect from power surges that may damage sensitive electronic components.

Water and Other Liquid Sources

Do not install game near sprinkler or other water jet sources. Do not use water jet to clean game. Keep minimum clearance behind game and wall for proper ventilation but also prevent access of liquid from spills and sprays from entering ventilation holes.

Connectors

When servicing machine, ensure all connectors mate properly. If connectors do not slip in easily, do not force them. Connectors are often keyed and only connect one way. Check for correct orientation.

Computer

The computers contain sensitive components, including a hard drive. Do not handle it roughly. Contact your distributor before servicing its internal components. Ask about warranty information as it relates to the PC. Cycle AC power on or off with the cabinet power switch.

A dongle has been inserted into one of the USB ports. This is required for game play.

Do not remove the dongle except for troubleshooting purposes.

Tempered Glass Warning

When handling the LCD display glass cover take special care and set the glass down softly on a flat surface free of debris. The edge of the glass is sensitive to hard impact. Shattered glass from the monitor can travel long distances and cause bodily injury. Use proper procedures when handling broken materials.

Ventilation

It is critical that the game is installed in a manner that allows for proper ventilation and air flow. Game must be installed so that there is a minimum amount of clearance between the wall or another game to allow good air circulation through the game cooling fan and vents.

Hazard to Epileptics

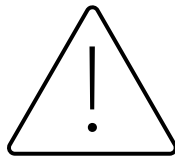

For reasons such as performance, this product's specifications may change without notice. Federal patent, copyright and other intellectual property laws protect the content, devices and design of the game and its equipment.



CAUTION

- This machine features moving parts and should only be serviced by a trained and experienced technician.
- Turn off all power and air supply before servicing the machine.
- Keep area around the machine clear and free of objects that present a trip hazard. Allow for plenty of room for players to safely enter and exit the machine.
- Observe ALL of the following guidelines to prevent injury, accident, or damage.
 - Maximum of two persons on the machine at any time.
 - If a player fatigues or experiences motion sickness or is unable to continue the game for any reason, stop the game motion immediately by pressing the MOTION STOP button. Allow the person to rest and exit the game with assistance if needed.
 - Remain seated for the entire duration of the game. Do not stand or exit while the game is moving. Press the MOTION STOP button before exiting the game.
 - Keep hands and legs inside the game at all times while in motion. Remain in the game until game comes to a complete stop.
 - Do not attempt to reach for objects on the floor or near the game when it is moving. Stay clear and stand at a safe distance while game is in motion.
 - Small children should always be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- The machine is equipped with safety features which the operator and the player need to be familiar with:
 - There is a MOTION STOP button located in between of player 1 and 2. This button will stop the motion feature once pressed.
 - Bellows around the moving part of the machine prevent access between the base and the moving part. Make sure that the bellows are not damaged or showing signs of excessive wear that could lead to failure. Replace the bellows when this occurs. Use only tamper proof screw fasteners as specified.
 - The machine is designed so that there is no unintended movement in the absence of a logic signal as might be experienced during a power outage. Make sure that the machine is safe to operate before turning power back ON.
- Critical parts should be maintained and inspected regularly for safe operation. If those critical parts are damaged, broken, or installed incorrectly, replace them, or install correctly. Use only manufacturer's specified parts for continued safety and reliability. Contact your distributor to order replacement parts.

Setup

Safety Notice

Installing this product requires three individuals able to lift heavy objects safely. Two 6-foot step ladders (minimum height) are required as part of the installation process. Make sure that you are familiar with the manual contents, game setup, and operations before you begin the installation process. Do not push or pull on the decorative items when completing the assembly to prevent damaging these parts. Be aware of your surroundings and individuals around you during the assembly process for your safety and the safety of others. Work only in an area with sufficient lighting and a clean, level surface.

Unpack Materials

1. Place the shipping crate(s) on a flat, stable surface.
2. Cut the banding straps and remove the cardboard, plastic sleeve, foam, and other packing materials.
3. Stage all sub-assemblies and components near the final assembly area.
4. Locate the keys taped to the coin door on the motion platform and to the ledge on monitor cabinet.
5. Check for shipping damage to the following:
 - Monitor(s)
 - Monitor bracket
 - Headset arm(s)
 - Headset(s)
 - Cabinet decals
6. Check the AC line cords for visible signs of damage.

Pay particular attention to the plug and line cord insulation.

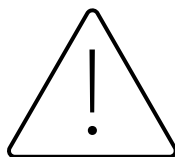

4. Ratcheting socket wrench and the following sockets
 - a. 7/16" socket
 - b. 3/8" socket
 - c. 1/4" socket
 - d. 10mm or 13mm socket

Cabinet Assembly

Install Spacer Bracket and Connect Motion Platform to Monitor Cabinet

1. Locate spacer bracket sub-assembly with hardware bag (note (4) additional sets of bolts installed on bracket which will be used later to install wood spacer cap panel). Bring components near the motion platform and monitor cabinet along with 7/16" socket driver.
2. Tuck platform's cables and tubing into access holes to avoid crushing and align spacer bracket with (4) mounts on motion platform. Use 7/16" socket with 1/4"-20 x 3/4" bolts with external tooth lock washers to secure spacer bracket to motion platform. (**IMAGE 1-1**)

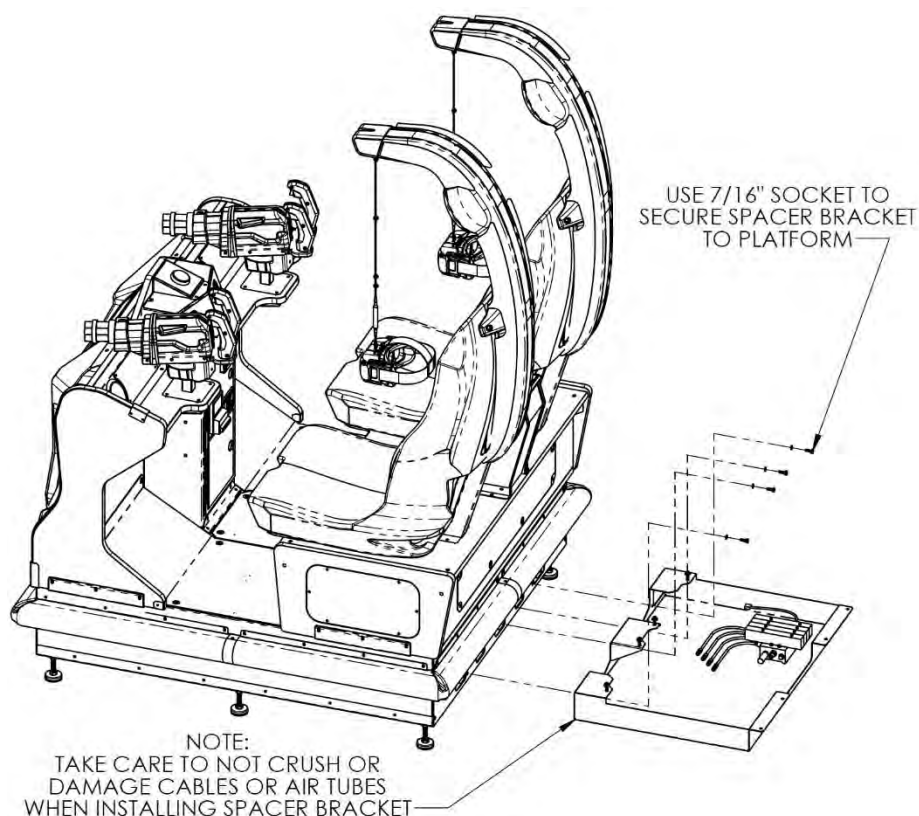

- Next, roll the motion platform in front of monitor cabinet, orient the spacer bracket to be flush and centered onto cabinet's wood ledge and aligned with (6) mounts. Use 7/16" socket with 1/4"-20 x 1" bolts with split lock washers to secure to monitor cabinet. (**IMAGE 1-2**)

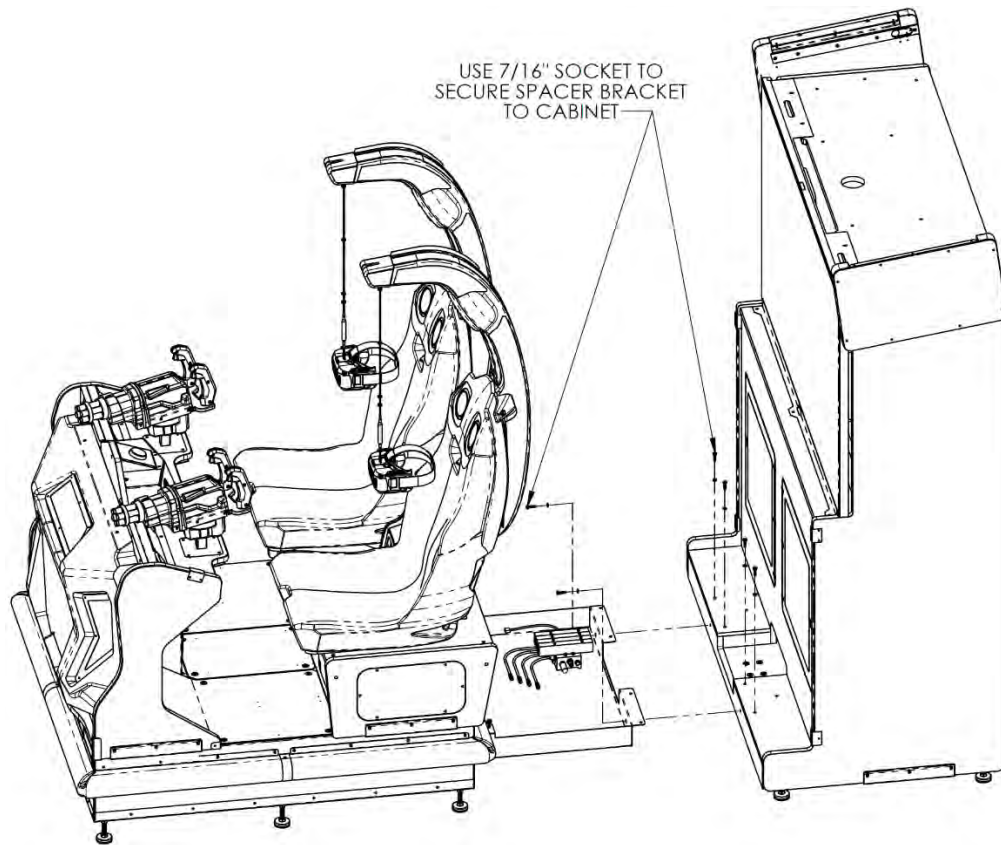

- Save remaining screws, including those attached to bracket, for mounting spacer cap panel.

Install Upper Monitor Mounting Bracket

NOTE: It is strongly recommended that the game NOT be moved once the upper monitor is installed. Access to back doors will be required in future steps. Plan for adequate AC power and future rear service access needs before completing the next steps.

1. Locate the upper monitor mounting bracket sub-assembly with hardware bag. Set up ladders next to the monitor cabinet.
2. Place upper monitor mounting bracket in position on top of the cabinet, such that (4) mounting slots in bracket align with corresponding holes on cabinet (DO NOT DROP). Use 1/4"-20 x 1-1/4" bolts with split lock washers and flat washers and hand-tighten the bracket such that it is in its rearmost position. These (4) bolts will be fully tightened using 7/16" socket once the upper monitor has been installed. Additionally, remove the wood shipping blocks from top of cabinet with 1/4" socket or flathead bit if they were not removed during unpacking (**IMAGE 2-1**)

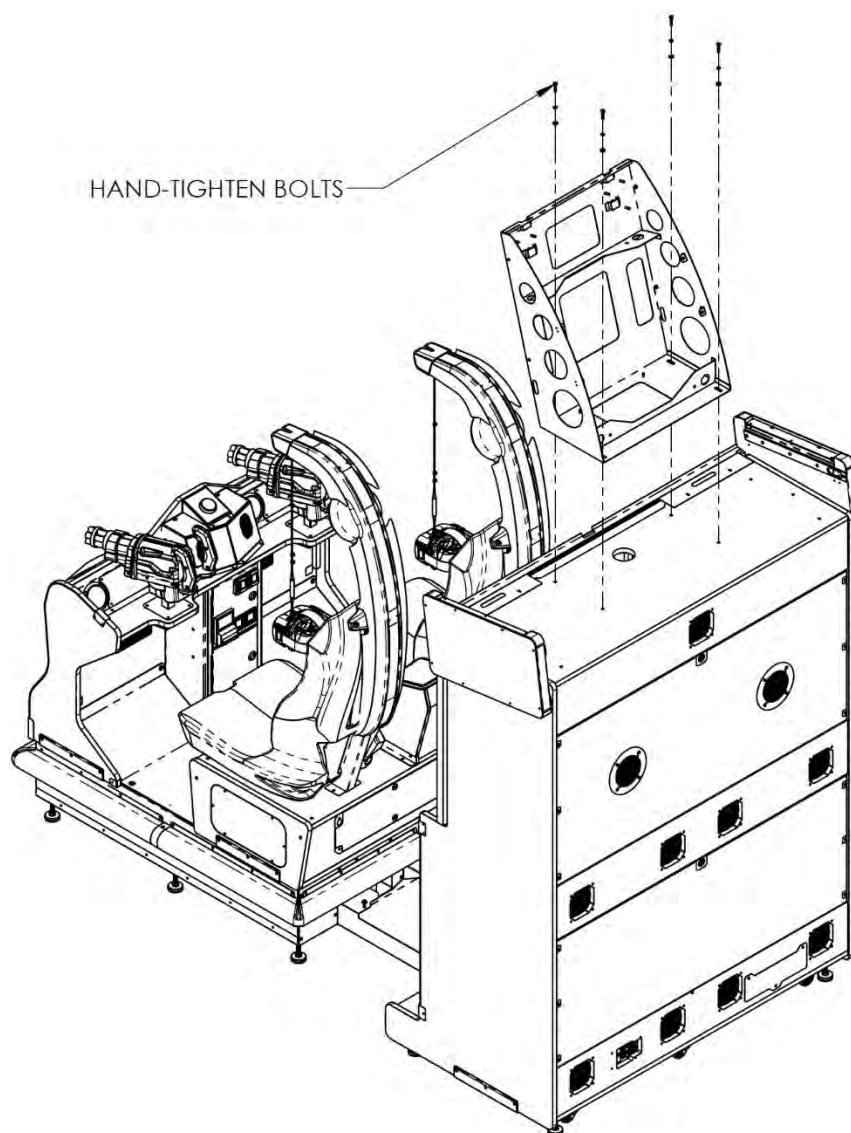

Install Hanger Bracket on Upper Monitor

NOTE: Monitors change throughout production. Monitor's voltage specifications should always match game voltage specifications (120V or 230V).

1. Locate universal hanger bracket with accompanying hardware bag and supplied monitor.
 - a. FOR SAMSUNG QB65C: Lay out (4) M8 x 50MM bolts and split lock washers, (4) spacers, and 13MM socket driver. Save (4) 1/4"-20 x 3/4" bolts and split lock washers for future step.
 - b. FOR LG 65UR340C: Lay out (4) M6 x 16MM bolts and split lock washers and 10MM socket driver (no spacers are used). Save (4) 1/4"-20 x 3/4" bolts and split lock washers for future step.
2. After carefully unpacking monitor, place hanger bracket over top edge of monitor centered on VESA mounts, while monitor is preferably held upright securely. Use appropriately sized socket and supplied hardware (bolts & washers, and spacers where applicable) to secure the hanger bracket to monitor's VESA mounts (DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN). (**IMAGE 3-1 & 3-2 & 3-3**)

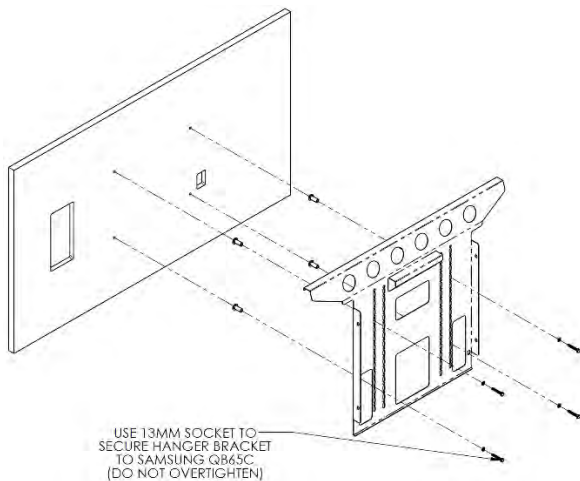

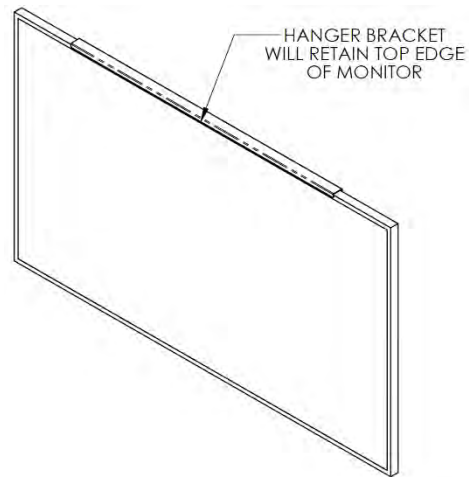

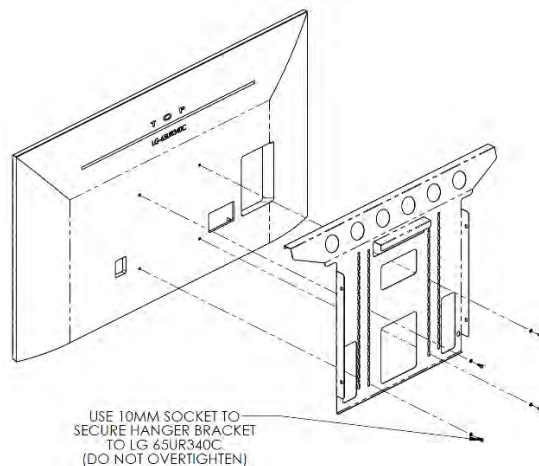

3. Place remaining bolts with washers and 3/8" socket atop cabinet for next steps.

Install Upper Monitor on Mounting Bracket

1. With ladders set up next to game, (2) individuals should carry the monitor over to cabinet.
2. Climb the ladders and hang the monitor over the mounting bracket, while making sure that the lower edge of monitor is retained behind the full-width cross bracket attached to the top front edge of monitor cabinet. As necessary, shift the mounting bracket forward to close gap or back to create space. (**IMAGE 4-1**)

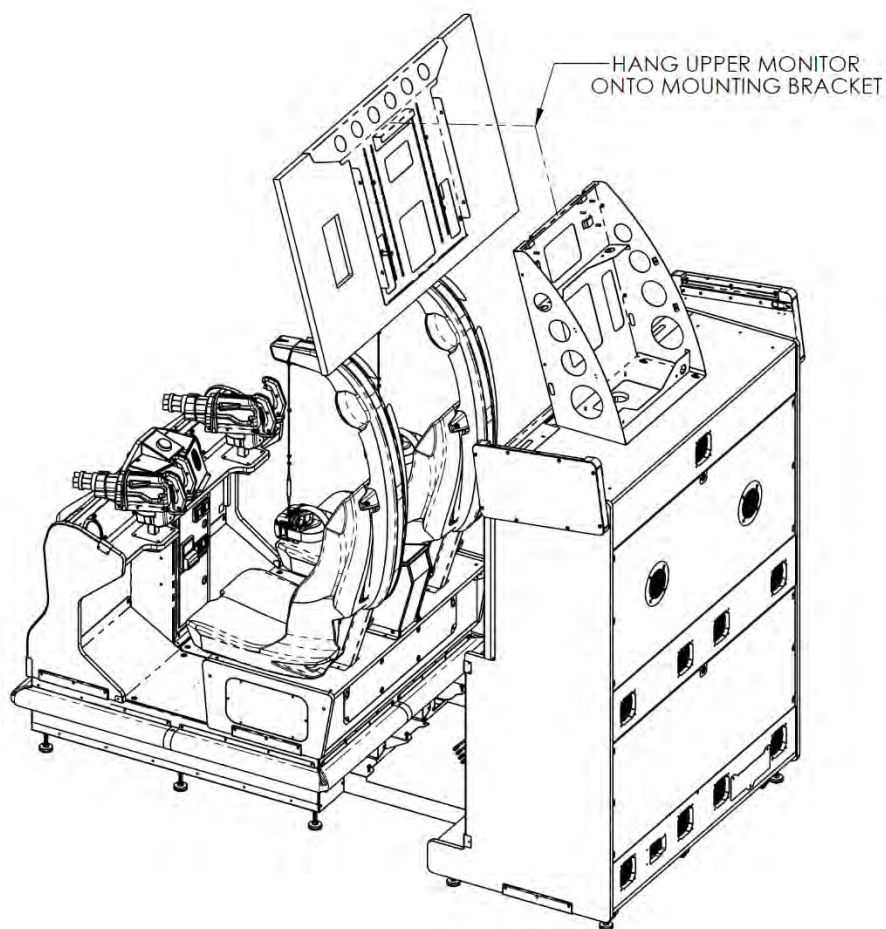

3. **(IMPORTANT)** Center monitor and use 3/8" socket with 3/4" bolts and split lock washers to secure hanger to mounting bracket. **(IMAGE 4-2)**

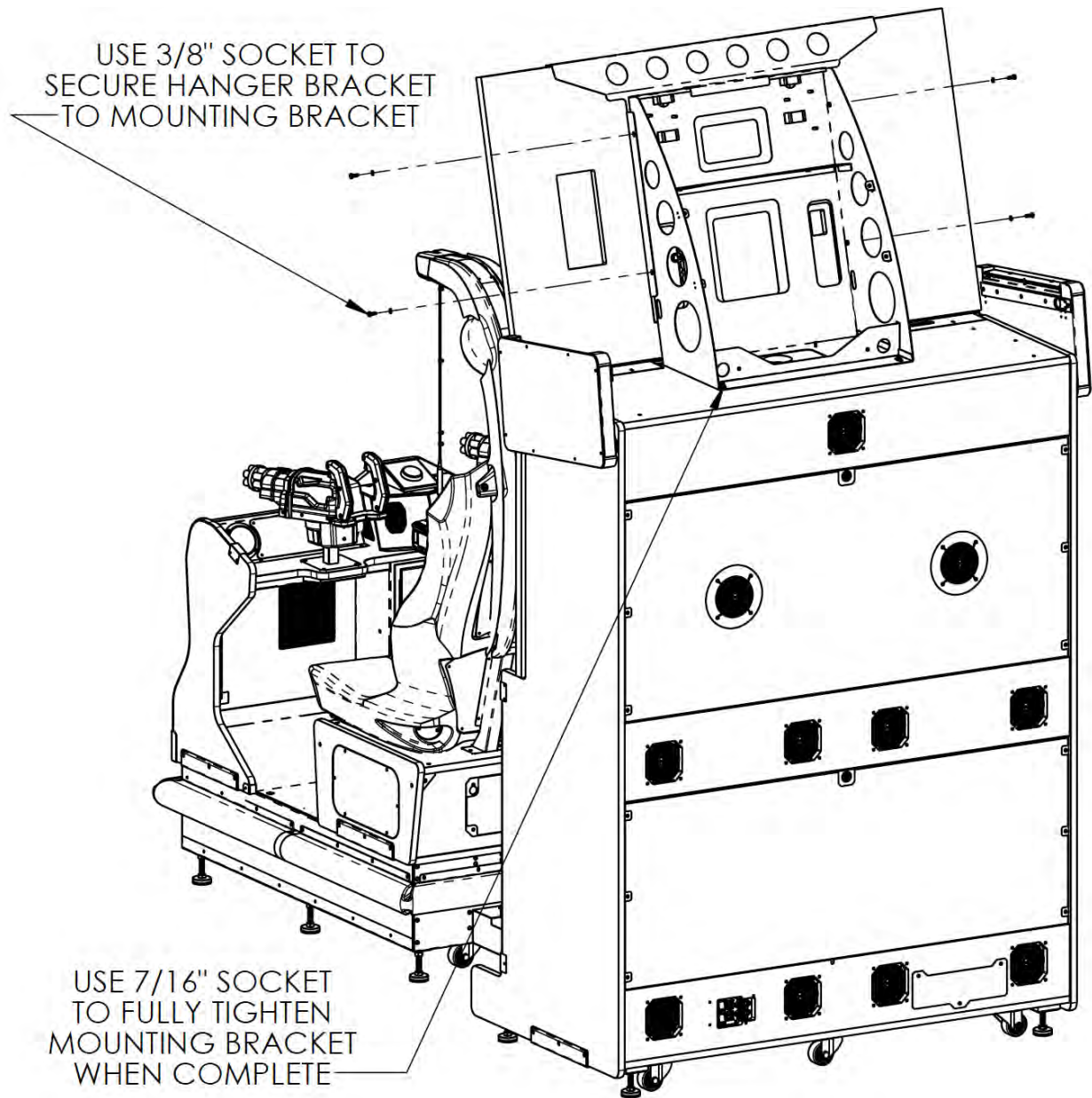

4. Nudge mounting brackets forward such that lower edge of monitor is flush with cross bracket, then use 7/16" socket to fully secure the (4) bolts that were hand-tightened when mounting bracket was installed on top of the cabinet.

Install Topper Support Brackets

1. Use Phillips bit driver to remove (6) shipping screws securing upper and lower back doors of monitor cabinet. Once screws are removed, use keys to open and remove doors and safely place off to the side.
2. Use 7/16" socket to remove left and right topper support brackets from inside cabinet (note: hardware bags attached to each bracket in addition to (3) sets of screws installed along angled rear edges). (**IMAGE 5-1**)

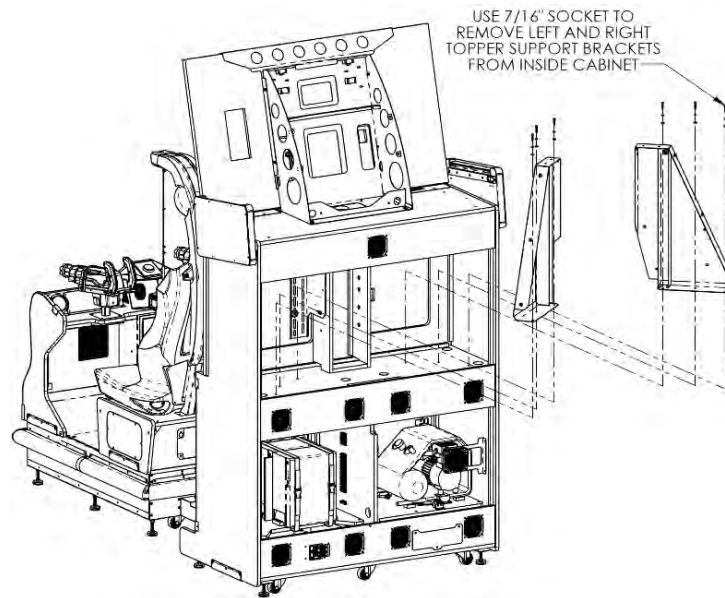

3. Locate cardboard box containing topper sub-assembly and unpack (take care not to damage). You should also find a loose topper support bracket with hardware bag attached. Attach topper support bracket to left and right topper support brackets with supplied (4) 1/4"-20 x 1/2" bolts with split lock washers and flat washers. These bolts should also be hand-tightened. (**IMAGE 5-2**)

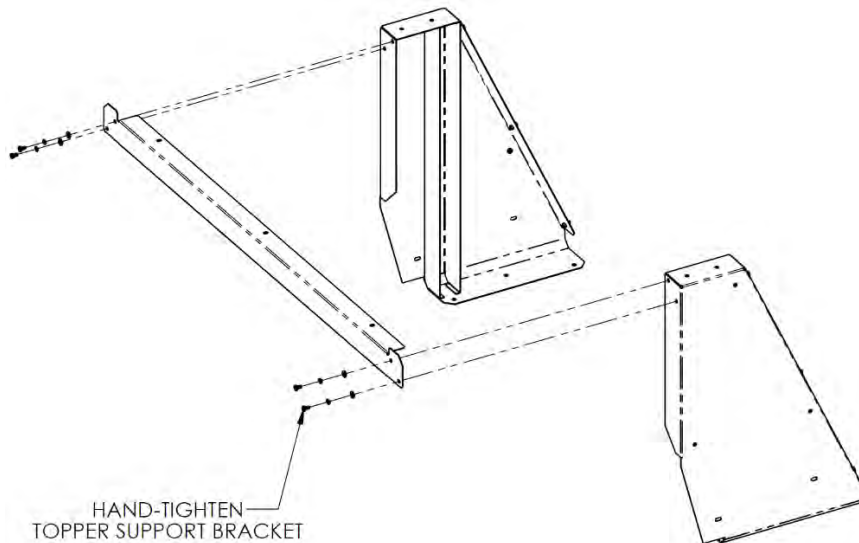

4. With ladders set up next to game, carefully carry assembled topper support brackets up to top of cabinet and align with mounting holes. Reuse hardware and hand-tighten the bracket in place.

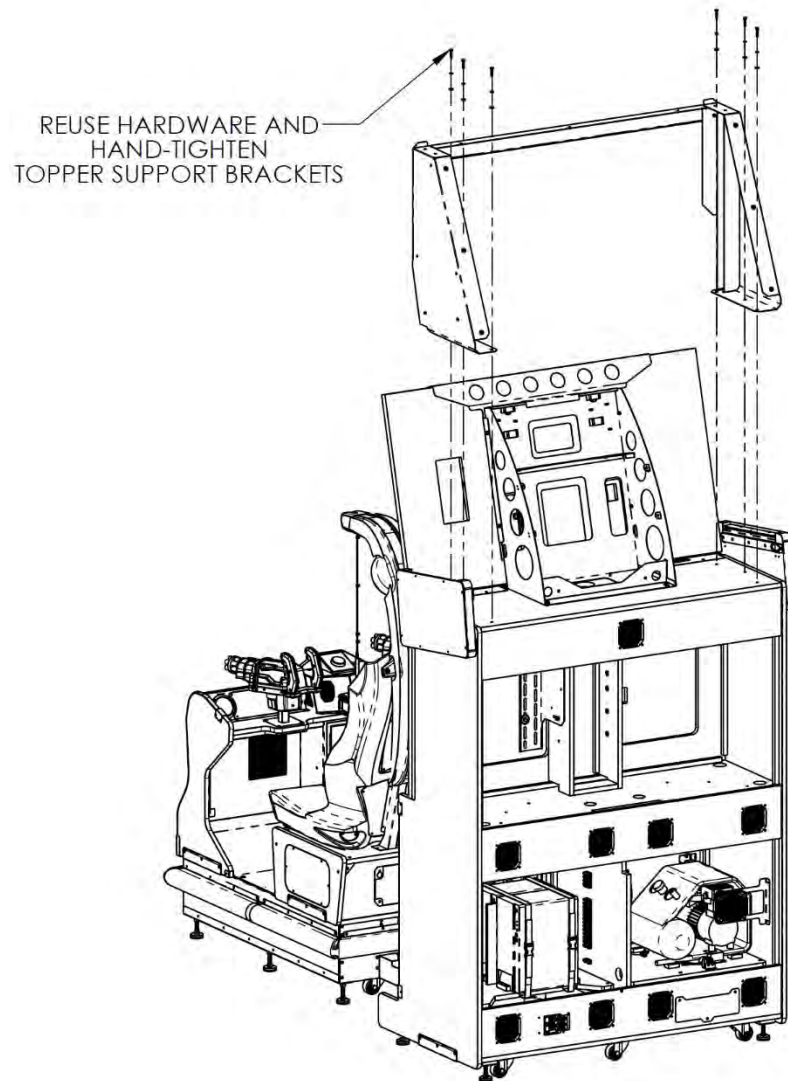

Install Topper

1. Locate hardware bag attached to topper and place atop cabinet with 7/16" socket.
2. (2) individuals should carry topper up ladders and set onto support brackets, taking care not to crush cables. First, install topside outer bolts, (4) 1/4"-20 x 1-1/4" bolts with split lock washers and flat washers, into left and right support bracket mounts.
3. Next, install (3) 1/4"-20 x 1" bolts with split lock washers and flat washers along front underside of topper thru topper support bracket. Use 7/16" socket to fully tighten all topper and topper support mounts (17 total). (**IMAGE 6-1**)

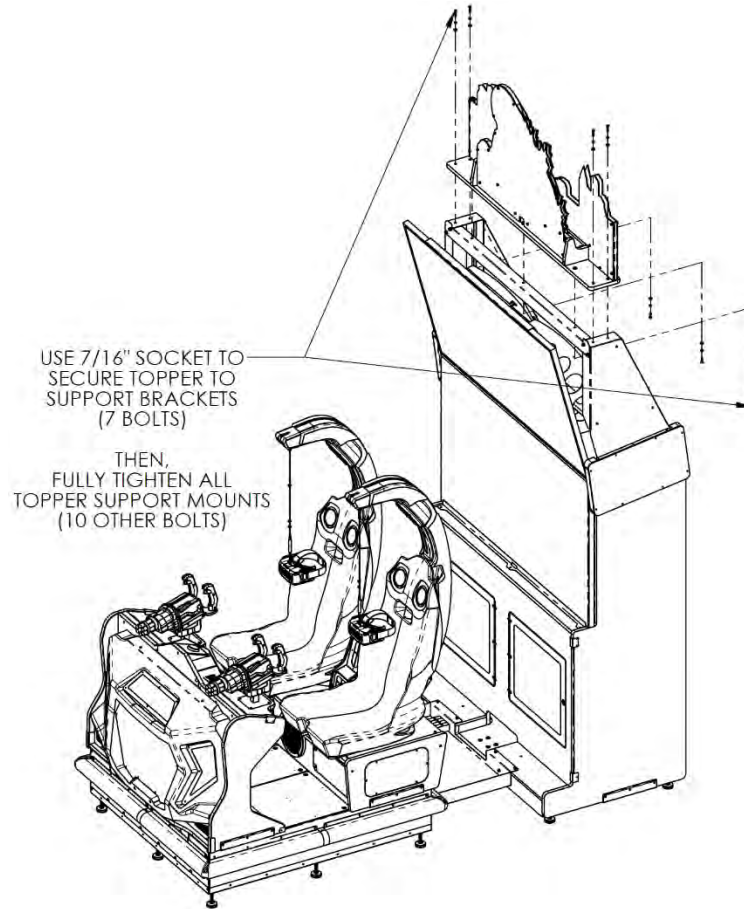

4. Retrieve loose 6-pin connector from topper cable through central access hole on underside of topper, route through cabinet's access hole, and plug into mating connector just inside of cabinet
5. Locate HDMI cable for upper monitor inside cabinet and locate upper monitor's supplied line cord. Using wireway hole at the top of cabinet, install HDMI cable into "HDMI 1" port of upper monitor and install AC line cord into AC power port. This HDMI cable should plug into HDMI port of "PLAYER 2" PC and the AC line cord should be plugged into AC receptacle located on left side of cabinet when viewed from the back of the game.
6. Replace back doors when complete (save shipping screws or discard).

Install Upper Graphic Panels

1. Locate (3) upper graphic panels (left, right, and rear). Unpack hardware bags attached to left and right topper support brackets which will be used to mount left and right upper graphic panels.
2. Place right upper graphic panel in place in between right topper support bracket and right lightbox assembly attached to cabinet side. Use T27 driver with (3) 1/4"-20 x 3/4" tamperproof bolts and flat washers to loosely secure panel to mounts on right topper support bracket. (**IMAGE 7-1**)

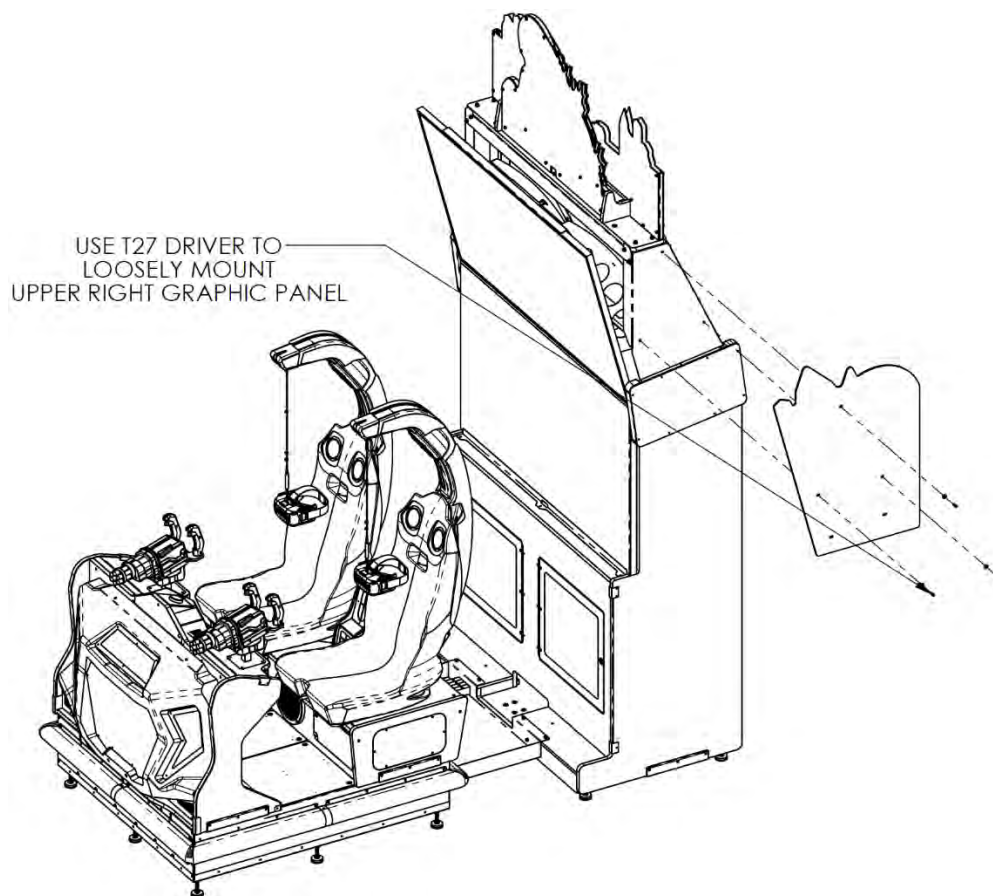

3. Use 7/16" socket with (2) 1/4"-20 x 1" bolts with split lock washers and flat washers and install bolts from inner surface of right topper support bracket, through upper right graphic panel, and into mounts on right lightbox. Once all (5) bolts are installed, tighten fully and repeat process for left side. **(IMAGE 7-2)**

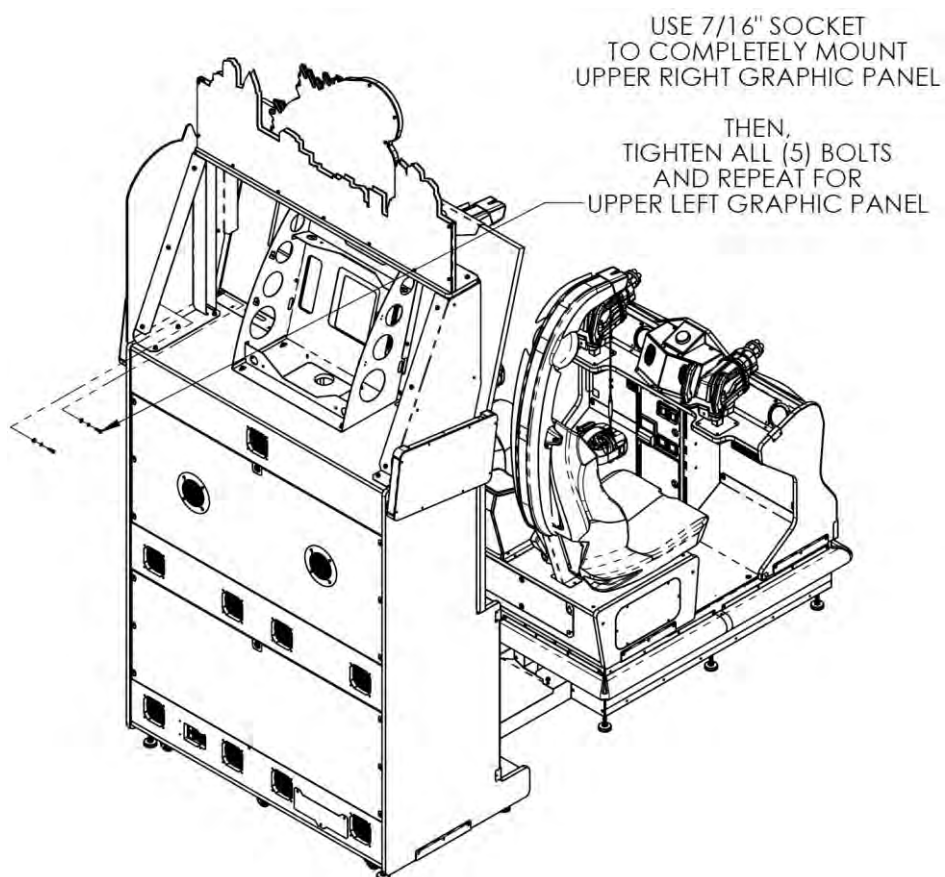

4. Use T27 driver to remove (6) screws and washers attached to angled rear edges of left and right topper support brackets. Place upper rear graphic panel onto angled rear edge and replace screws and washers. (**IMAGE 7-3**)

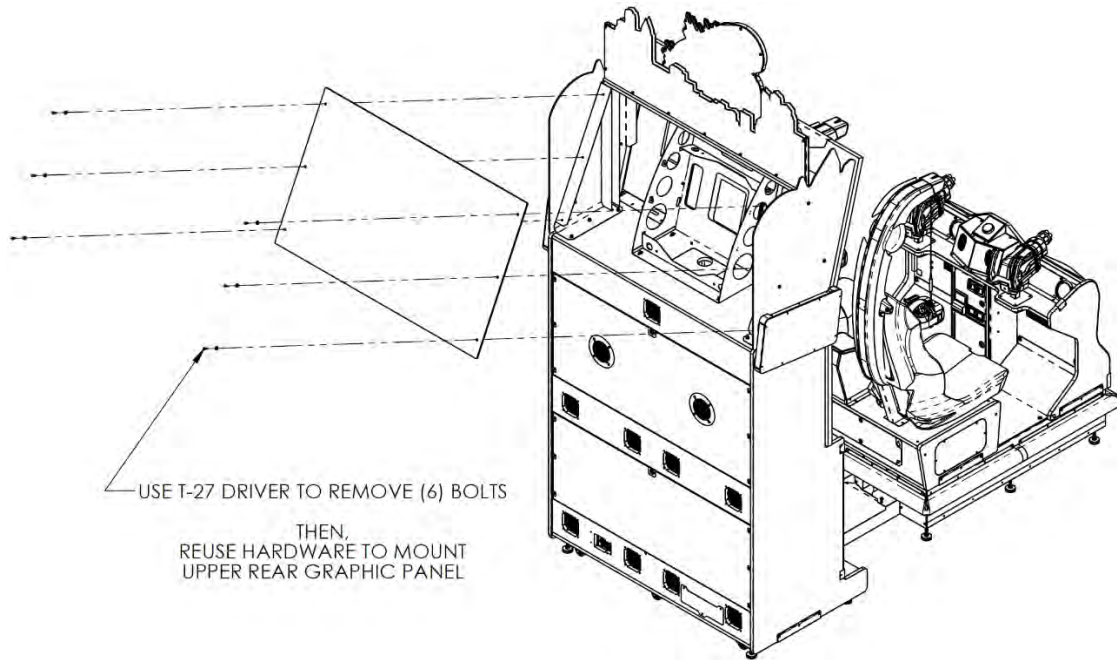

Install Downlighting Assemblies on Motion Platform

1. Locate (6) downlighting assemblies and accompany hardware bag. Note that there are (3) assemblies where wires exit on right side of the bracket and (3) where wires exit on left side.
2. Using images below for reference, place downlighting assemblies in their wiring-specific locations and connect to mating connectors near cable clamps at corners on underside of platform base. Then, taking care not to crush any wires, install assemblies on front and sides of platform base by inserting brackets tabs into cutouts on underside of platform base and rotating the assembly into place such that the (3) brackets holes align with platforms mounts. Use T-25 driver to securely mount. (**IMAGE 8-1 & 8-2**)

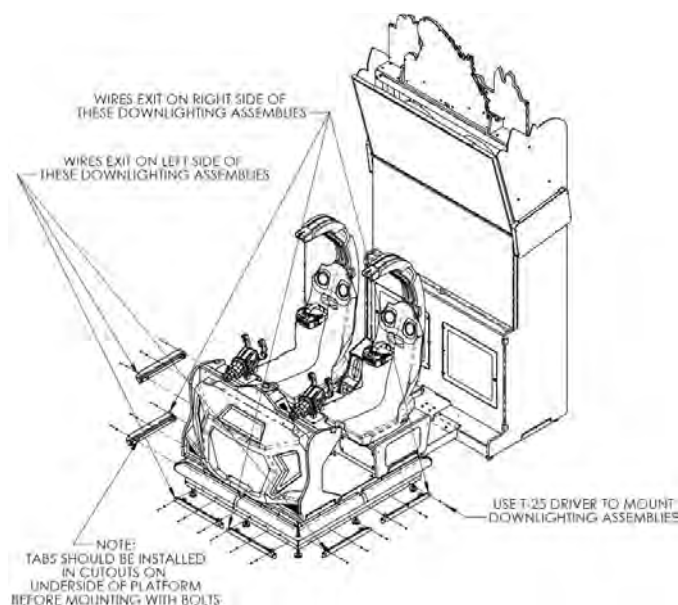

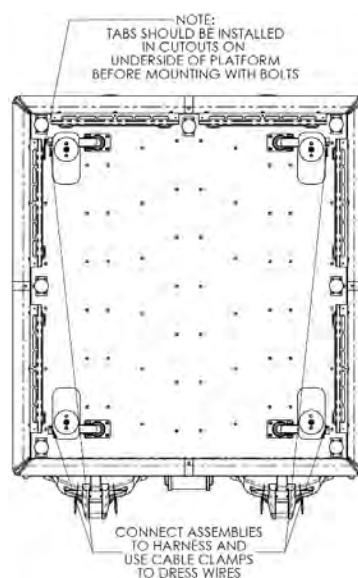

3. After downlighting assemblies are secure, use cable clamps to dress wires and tuck excess wire slack back into access holes.

Completing Platform Harness, Air, and Headset Connections

1. Retrieve all harness, air tubes, and headset cables from platform access holes and place within spacer bracket.
2. Retrieve matching connections from within monitor cabinet's central access tunnel and connect the following:
 - (10) harness connections
 - connectors are keyed.
 - (5) air tube connections
 - air supply line from compressor to connect into spacer bracket's manifold.
 - match platform air tubes with cabinet air tubes (0, 1, 2, 3).
 - (3) headset connections each for P1 and P2 headsets
 - USB – Match to P1 or P2 PC in cabinet.
 - display port – Match to P1 or P2 PC in cabinet.
 - power (barrel connector).
3. **IMPORTANT** – When fully connected, a portion of the headsets' cable slack should be tucked within the platform. This placement will allow the cable's slack within platform to move up and down gently when the game is in motion and prevent the cables from being pulled due to cable tension. As a check on proper placement, the visible headset cables running through spacer bracket should not move while the game is in motion.



Install Spacer Cap Panel and Lower Leg Levelers

1. Remove (4) sets of bolts installed on spacer bracket for spacer cap panel using T27 driver. Additionally, locate spacer cap panel and remaining loose hardware saved earlier. (**IMAGE 10-1**)

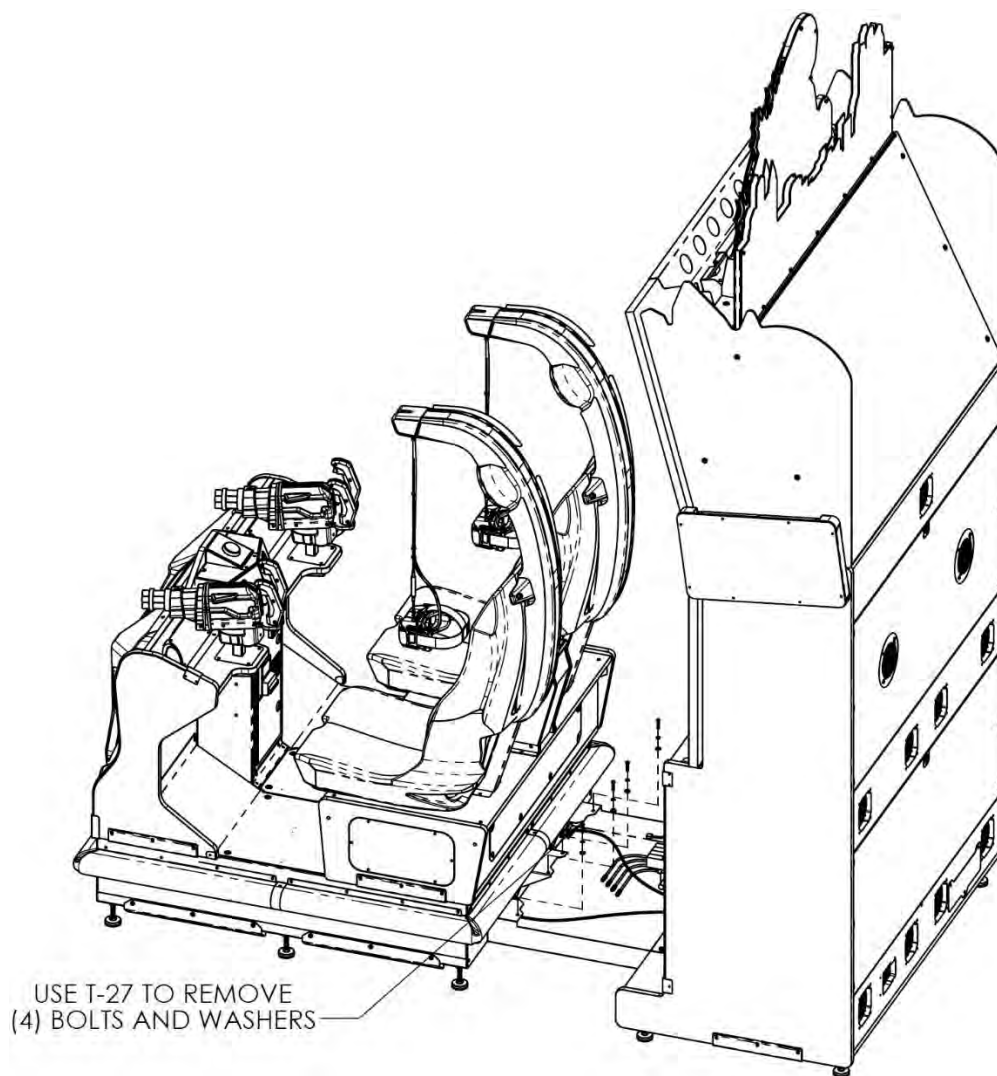

2. Check that all cables and air tubes are contained within spacer bracket and cabinet's central wireway channel and will not be crushed when placing spacer cap panel.

3. Place spacer cap panel and secure to spacer bracket and cabinet with T-27 driver, using (4) 1-1/4" bolts and split lock washers and flat washers on platform side and (2) 2-1/2" bolts and split lock washers and flat washers on cabinet side. (**IMAGE 10-2 & 10-3**)

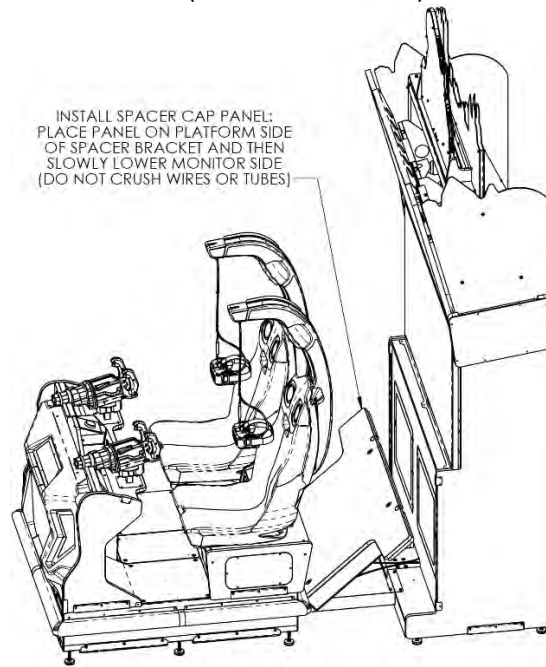

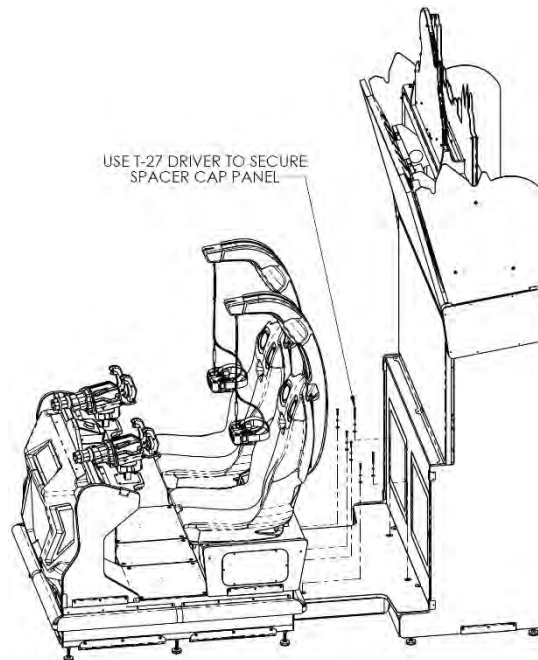

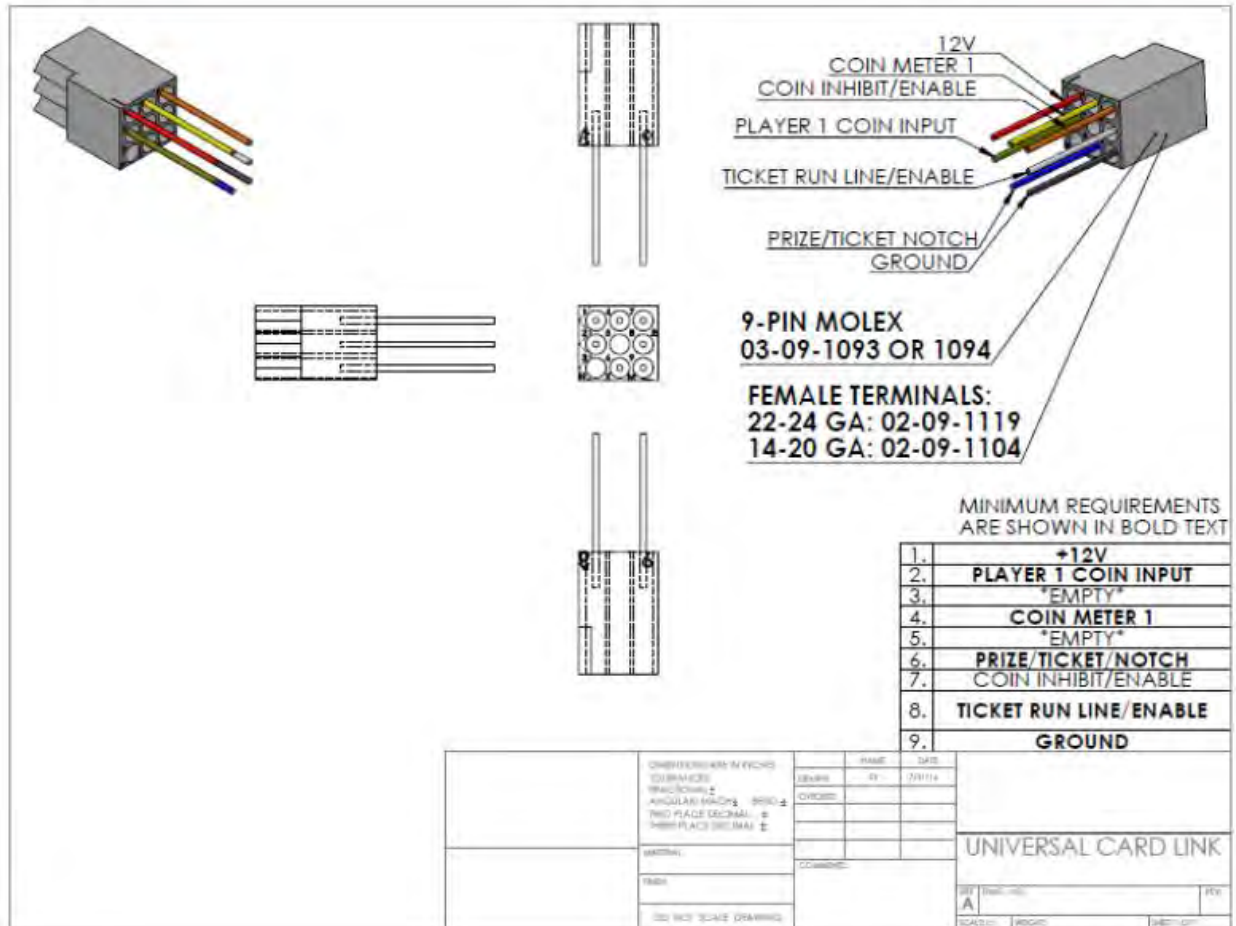
4. Lower all leg levelers to floor. There are (4) leg levelers on the monitor cabinet and (7) on the motion platform. Once leg levelers are done, raise the jam nuts on leg levelers up to mounting plate's weld nuts.

Card Reader Installation and Setup

Due to the rising popularity of aftermarket debit card systems for cashless or coinless operation of amusement machines (i.e., Embed, Intercard, Semnox), this Godzilla Kaiju Wars VR™ cabinet is equipped with UCL compatible harnessing to ensure that the installation process is easier and less prone to miswiring.

UCL, or Universal Card Link, is a debit card standard established by the American Amusement Machine Association. Visit <https://coin-op.org/standardization/> for the latest UCL standard and manual information.

The UCL connections on the game use pins 1, 2, 6, 8, and 9. The other pins are unused. Each UCL connector can supply up to 1A at 12VDC.



You can choose to use 1 or 2 card readers in the pricing adjustments section of the test menu. It is recommended to use 2 card readers for best results and player access.

There are (2) supplied connections, each located under the control panel of the Front Cabinet assembly. There is enough slack to accommodate mounting (2) card readers on the front panels, as each operator desires.

If only (1) card reader will be used, it is recommended that the card reader be mounted to the center dash door, any UCL connection can be used for games equipped with only (1) card reader.

Check Electrical Settings

1. Verify the voltage in the nearest AC outlet.
2. Verify the AC outlet ground connection is present and working.

*****Recommended: Dedicated 20A circuit breaker for each line cord to prevent capacity overload. (10A/each for 230VAC)*****

Startup Game

1. Plug the two line cords into an AC outlet (**Recommended: plug each line cord into a dedicated 20A circuit breaker to prevent capacity overload. (10A/each for 230VAC)**)
2. Turn the main cabinet power switches on (there are two switches, GAME and COMPRESSOR).
3. Calibrate the headsets (pgs. 31-35)

4. Verify the game and all components are operating normally. See *Basic Functional Test on Initial Power Up* in the *Diagnostics and Adjustments* section for the recommended procedure.

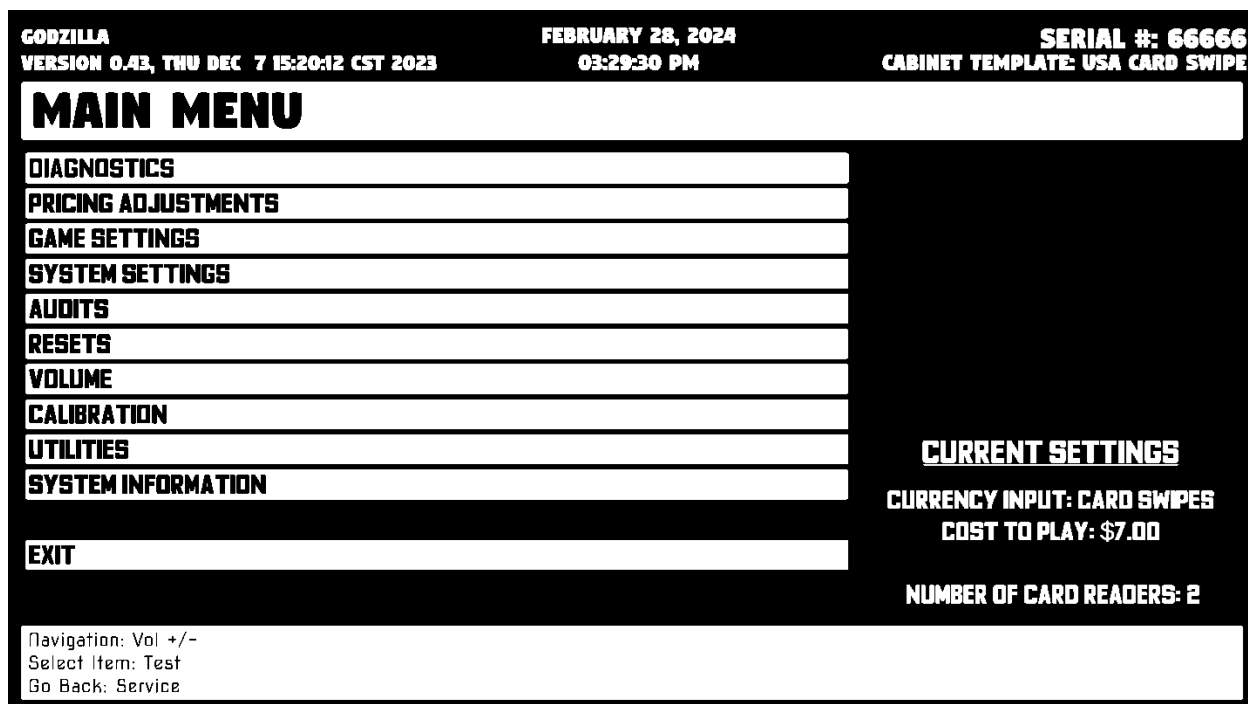

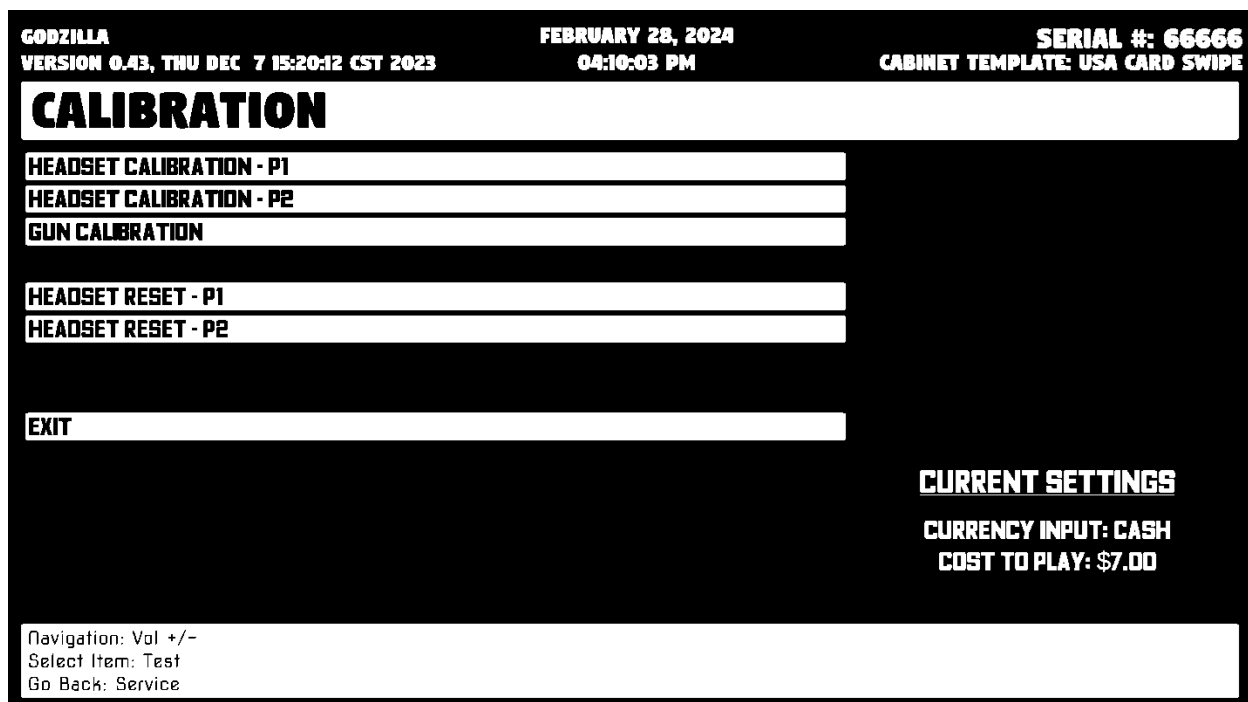

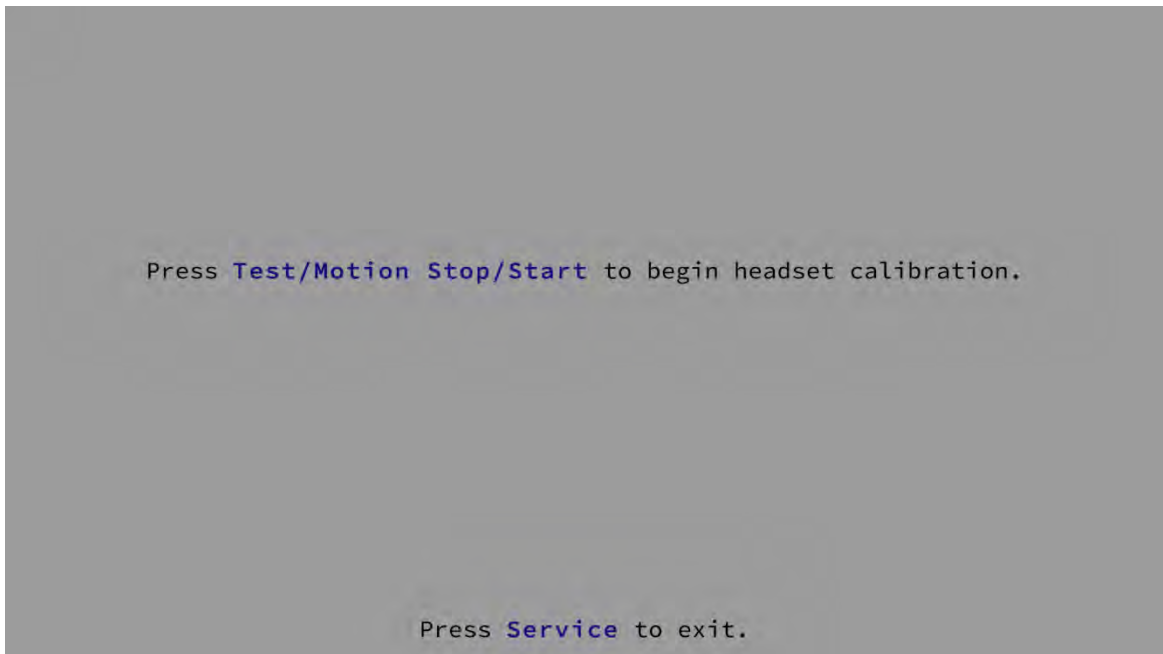
1. In the test menu, select the “**Calibration**” menu item. (see below)

- (2) 20-pin connections in the spacer cabinet can be mixed up and cross-connected.
- Mixing up these two connections will lead to:

 - **INOPERATION OF THE GAME** until the I/O board is replaced and the connections are swapped.

Solution:

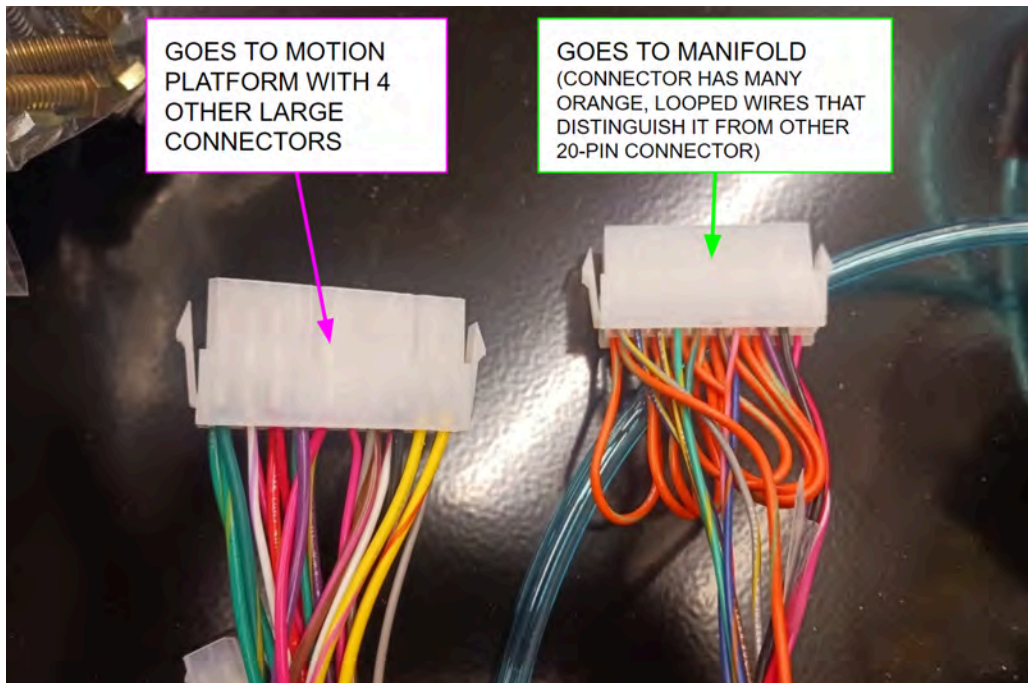
- **BEFORE POWERING ON THE MACHINE**, verify the (2) 20-pin connections are mated correctly (see images below).
- **IF THE RIO2 HAS ALREADY BEEN DAMAGED due to cross-connection:**
 - Power off the machine.
 - Verify the (2) 20-pin connections are mated correctly.
 - Replace the RIO2 board (located in the monitor cabinet on the electronics plate).
 - Power on the machine.
- To prevent this from happening in the future, use a ziptie to physically tie the 20-pin connector going to the motion platform to one of the other (4) connectors also going to the motion platform

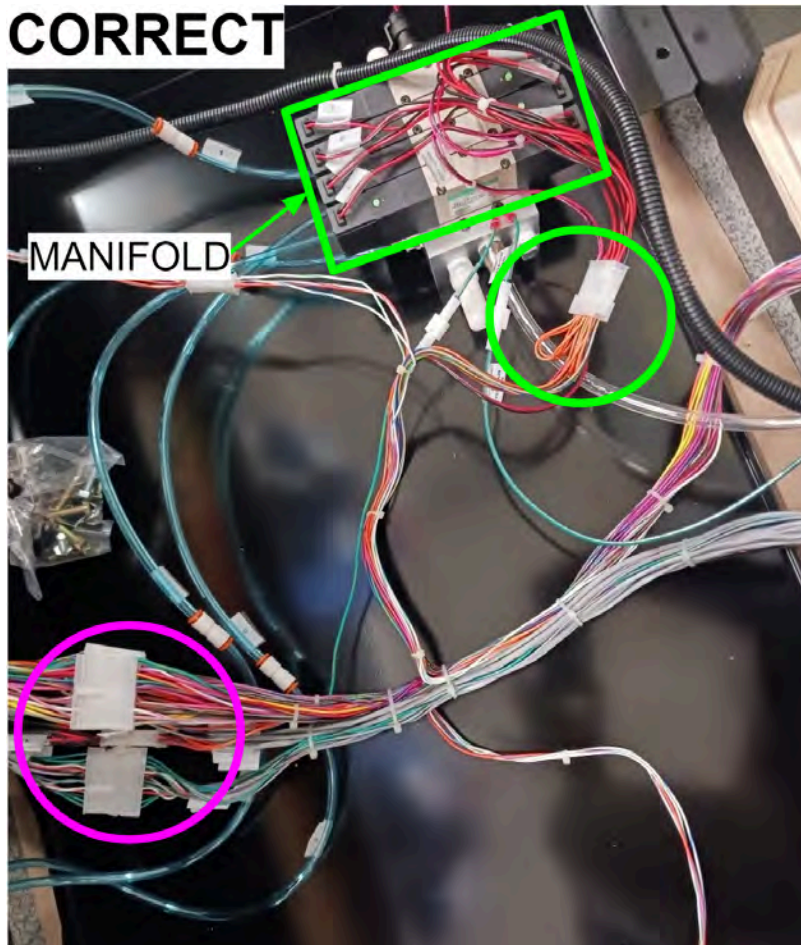

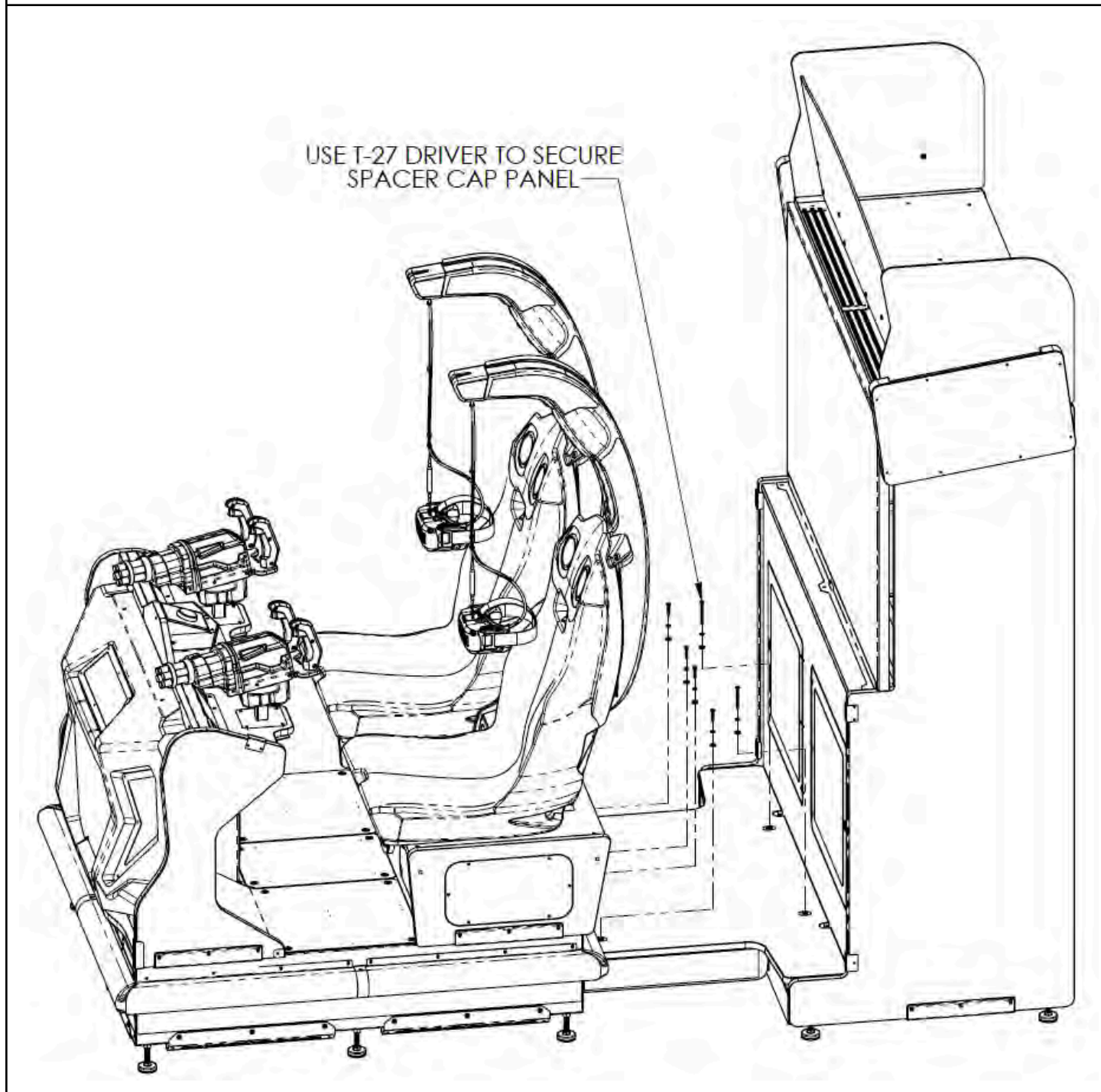

Problem:

- Various improvements have been made to hardware within headset rack assembly since the start of production to improve reliability of VR headset and cables. First production games were shipped without these improvements.

Solution:

- Follow procedure to update headset rack assemblies.

Required:

- Drill/Driver
- Driver Bits: T27 tamperproof, T15 tamperproof, 7/16" socket, 1/4" socket
- Wire Cutters (for Zip Tie Removal)

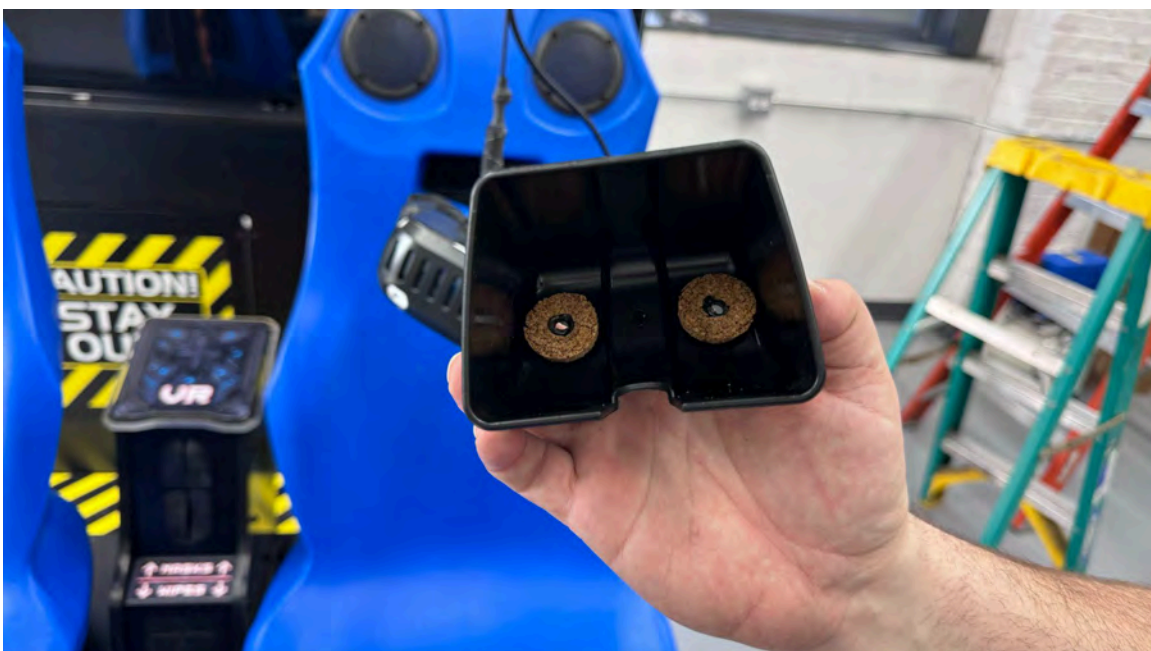
Included:

- (4) Adhesive-Backed Cork Washers
- (2) 1/4"-20 x 3/4" Tamperproof Button Head Bolts
- (2) 1/2" Cable Clamps
- (2) #8 x 5/8" Hex Head Tapping Screws

Procedure: All parts included to complete all updates. Note that some games may already have some of these updates implemented.

Step 1 : Use T27 tamperproof driver to remove (2) screws securing each P1 and P2 rack end caps. Install (2) provided adhesive-backed cork washers centered on mounting holes on inner surface of both end caps. Set parts and screws aside.



Step 2 : Use 7/16" driver to remove hex bolt and washer securing headset to rack, taking care to not drop headset after removing bolt. Reuse the washer and use T27 tamperproof driver with provided 1/4"-20 x 3/4" tamperproof bolt and washer to rehang headset securely. Repeat for second headset.



Step 3 : Use T15 tamperproof driver to remove (2) topmost screws securing headset rack rear cover, set screws aside, and peel back cover to reveal Occulink connection in recess. Use 1/4" socket driver with provided #8 x 5/8" hex head tapping screw to install provided 1/2" cable clamp near bottom of recess to retain end of Occulink connection of PC extension cable. Then, use T15 tamperproof driver to replace cover and screws.



Step 4 : Use T15 tamperproof driver to remove (2) bottommost screws securing headset rack rear cover, set screws aside, and lift up cover to determine if there is a zip tie securing headset cable to adhesive-backed zip tie pad. If the headset cable is secured by zip tie, use wire cutters to cut off zip tie (zip tie pad may also be removed). Then, use T15 tamperproof driver to replace cover and screws.



Step 5 : Use T27 tamperproof driver to replace both P1 and P2 rack end caps with cork washers added (end caps should retain loose top end of rear cover).

- Install 6ft of Convoluted Split Tubing with Zip Ties onto P1 & P2 Headsets' PC Extensions Cables for abrasion protection.

Required:

- Drill/Driver
- Driver Bits: T27 tamperproof
- Wire Cutters (for Zip Tie Trimming)

Included:

- (2) 6ft Sections of Convoluted Split Tubing, $\frac{3}{8}$ " Size
- (6) 4" Long Zip Ties

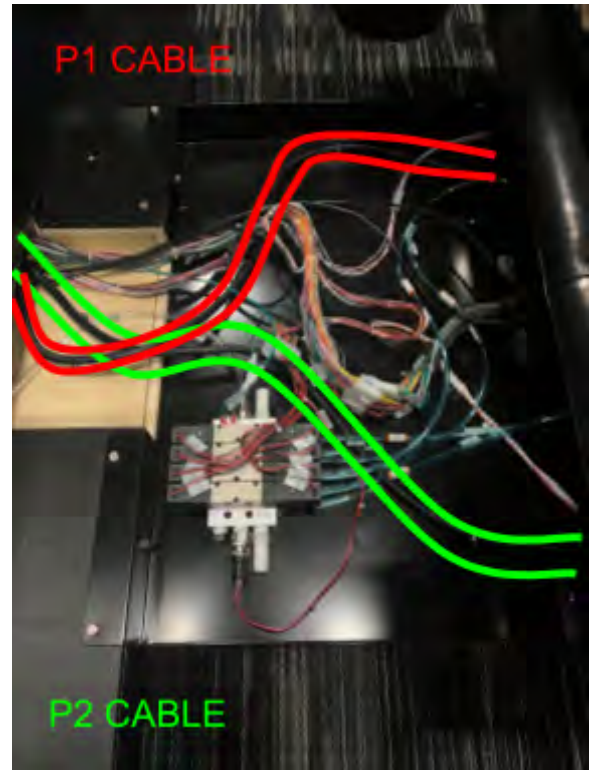

Procedure:

Step 1 : Use T27 tamperproof driver to remove (6) sets of screws and washers for spacer cap panel and (8) sets of screws and washers for seat cabinet rear access plate. Set parts and hardware aside. Additionally, use key to unlock and open PC front access door (P1 side of game).



Step 2 : Locate DPVR VR headset cable hub power boxes within spacer pan bracket or through PC access door. Install provided convoluted split tubing onto single cable side of each power box and slide tubing along cables, guiding through spacer pan, motion platform, and up into seat cabinet.



Step 2 (cont'd) : Then, install (3) zip ties over tubing (DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN) in the following locations: one near start at power box, another in spacer pan near where cable enters platform, and last near end within seat cabinet. Trim ends of zip ties with wire cutters.

Step 3 : Rearrange cables and tubes in spacer pan such that they will not be crushed when reinstalling spacer cap panel. Additionally, tuck portion of headset cable slack into platform to prevent tension on cable while platform is in motion. Reuse hardware and reinstall spacer cap panel and seat cabinet rear access plate using T27 tamperproof driver.

- Under normal use, it is possible for a section of Protective Tubing to slide out of the headset leading to reduced life of the short main cable.

Solution:

- Replace one zip-tie with a stronger gripping Zip Tie and add a clamp to hold the Protective Tubing in place. This kit contains parts for reworking two headsets.

Required:

- Phillips screwdriver
- Needle nose pliers
- Driver Bit: T10 Torx or tamperproof
- Wire Cutters

- (3) 4" long Zip Ties (1 is a spare)
- (2) Cable Clamps
- (2) T-10 Black Screws

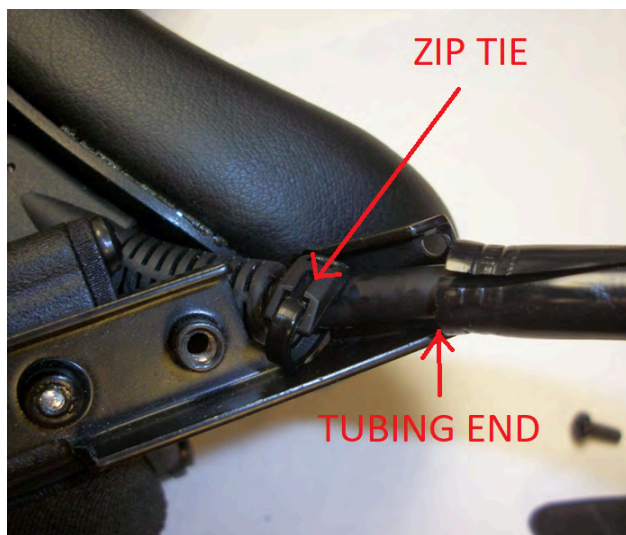
Procedure:

Step 1 : USING A PHILLIPS SCREWDRIVER, REMOVE THE (2) BLACK PHILLIPS SCREWS THAT HOLD THE PLASTIC COVER OVER THE AREA WHERE THE CABLE EXITS THE HEADSET. REMOVE THE PLASTIC COVER.

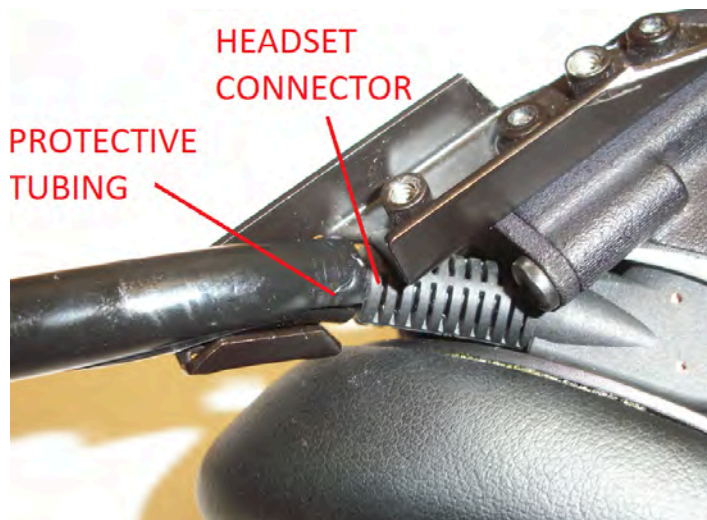


Step 2 : YOU WILL LIKELY SEE A ZIP TIE THAT HAS SLIPPED OFF OF THE END OF THE PROTECTIVE TUBING. HOWEVER, IT MAY STILL BE ON THE TUBING. IN EITHER CASE, USE THE WIRE CUTTERS TO CUT IT OFF.

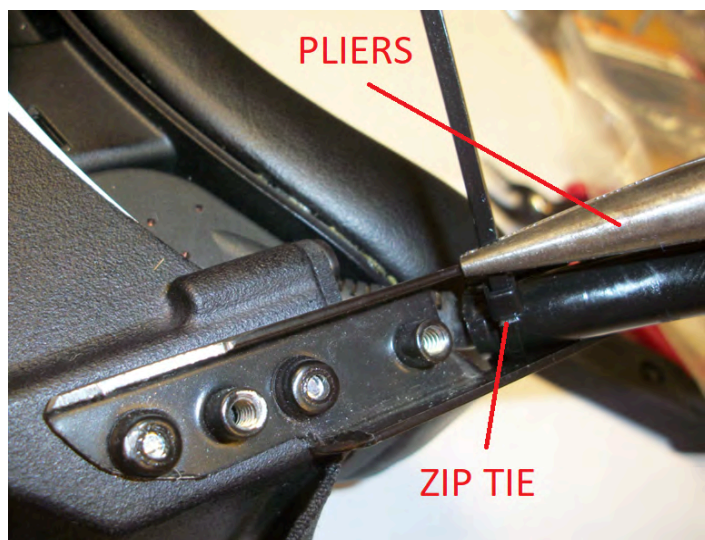
NOTE: BE CAREFUL NOT TO DAMAGE THE CABLE ITSELF!



Step 3 : SLIDE THE PROTECTIVE TUBING BACK DOWN TOWARD THE HEADSET CONNECTOR UNTIL IT IS JUST ABOUT TOUCHING THE CONNECTOR AT THE STRAIN RELIEF.



Step 4 : INSTALL A 4" ZIP TIE (ONE SPARE HAS BEEN INCLUDED, BUT IS NOT REQUIRED) ABOUT 1/8" FROM THE END OF THE PROTECTIVE TUBING AS SHOWN. PULL THE END WITH THE NEEDLE NOSE PLIERS AND TRY TO MAKE IT VERY TIGHT. CUT OFF THE EXTRA LENGTH.



Step 5 : REPLACE THE PLASTIC COVER AND THE (2) BLACK SCREWS.

Step 6 : INSTALL THE PROVIDED CABLE CLAMP TO THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE PROTECTIVE TUBING AS SHOWN BELOW. TO INSTALL, SPREAD THE CLAMP OPEN AND SLIP IT OVER THE CABLE AND INSTALL AND TIGHTEN THE INCLUDED SCREW USING A T-10 BIT AND DRIVER. DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN THE SCREW.
